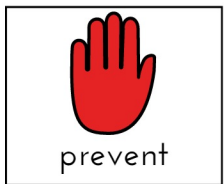


Prevent Duty at Activate

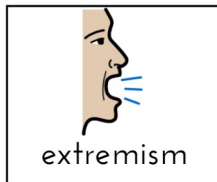
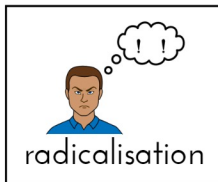
Prevent means stopping someone from doing something, or stopping something from happening

When we talk about the Prevent Duty, we are talking about stopping extremism and radicalisation from happening

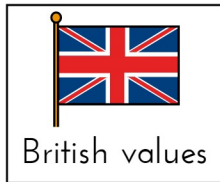


By following the Prevent Duty, we make sure that everyone at Activate feels safe and happy

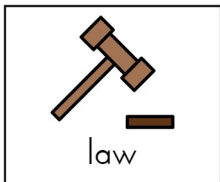


Prevent Duty at Activate

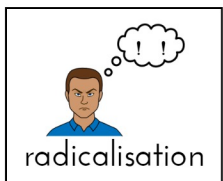
Extremism is going against British values.



Extremists do not agree with the ideas that we practice at college, like democracy, rule of law and tolerance to other people's beliefs and cultures
